CRITERION 3

Identify skills related to a job.

Distinguished

Identifies skills related to a job, and discusses personal skills already attained and skills needed to acquire to be successful at the job.

Proficient

Identifies skills related to a job.

Basic

Discusses a job, but does not identify the technical skills required for the job.

Non Performance

Does not identify skills related to a job.

CRITERION 4

Describe the degree to which the companies from the selected job postings seem to be appealing and trustworthy.

Distinguished

Describes the degree to which the companies from the selected job postings seem to be appealing and trustworthy. Notes how specific information literacy skills were used to inform the description.

Proficient

Describes the degree to which the companies from the selected job postings seem to be appealing and trustworthy.

Basic

Identifies the companies from the selected job postings. However, the reasoning for why the companies are appealing and trustworthy is missing or unclear.
